Built by Ken Nichols in Bideford, for Jack Paterson the car was converted in the 1970's for hill climbing with a Martin V8 engine. The car was discovered by Terry Van Der Zee in the 80's and fully restored to original specification.
Race History:	With a top driver this car has finished in the top 5 of the HSCC Historic FF Championship races. It is now fully prepared for the new season and also eligible for the Classic Formula Ford and HSCC Classic Racing Car Championship. Go on beat all those Merlyns and Lolas.
